Warlpiri	English
<i>jarnpa</i>	Sorcerers
<i>juju minyimin</i>	Plant used to clear nasal congestion (biological name: <i>pterocaulon sphacelatum</i>)
<i>jukurrpa</i>	Dreaming; a time during which ancestral beings roamed the landscape
<i>kardiya</i>	Individuals of European descent; white people
<i>kardiya-kurlangu</i>	Belonging to white people
<i>kuku</i>	Spirits of deceased individuals that roam around communities
<i>kurruwalpa</i>	Spirit being that implants <i>kuruwarri</i> into women to cause conception
<i>kuruwarri</i>	Customary law; designs; life force
<i>kuyu</i>	Meat and meat foodstuffs
<i>milalpa</i>	Spirits of ancestors which reside in, and protect, a kin group's country
<i>mint</i>	Bad cold or flu
<i>miyi</i>	Vegetable foods
<i>ngangkari</i>	Local healers capable of diagnosing and treating spiritual illness
<i>ngarl</i>	Bush honey
<i>nguwa</i>	Healing power possessed by <i>ngangkari</i>
<i>pama</i>	Delicacy foods
<i>pirilirpa</i>	Soul of living individuals
<i>warnayarra</i>	Rainbow serpent
<i>yapa</i>	Warlpiri, other Aboriginal, and Indigenous individuals
<i>yapa-kurlangu</i>	Belonging to <i>yapa</i> ; Aboriginal way
<i>yarda</i>	Sharpened bone magically implanted to cause illness
